Basic Eligibility criteria for C2C Referral:

- Willing to pursue services with the Department of Rehabilitation (DOR)
- Age 18+ with GED or high school diploma equivalent.
- Age 22+ and fully exited from any high school transition program.
- Have a documented diagnosis of an Intellectual Disability or Autism Spectrum Disorder.
- Must be able to verbally and in writing, state an obtainable goal for employment.
- The ability to understand and interact with college level material.
- Can benefit from the college experience with a focus on gainful employment.
