Background

The data in this report was collected by the San Diego Community College District (SDCCD) in accordance with the Title IX Equal Opportunity in Education Act to determine applicants' level of interest in intercollegiate athletics and whether the colleges are fulfilling the expressed demand of their applicants for opportunities to participate in sports. Data was collected from applicants who completed CCCApply in February through November of 2021 in an optional survey included in the application.

Respondents' Interest in Intercollegiate Athletics


Of the 565 respondents to the survey in CCCApply, 309 indicated they were interested in competing in intercollegiate sports (55%). 134 of these were female (43% of those interested in competing) and 175 of these were male (57% of those interested in competing).

Female Applicants' Responses


When female applicants indicated that they would be interested in competing in a sport, they most commonly expressed interest in volleyball (n=41). 15 respondents indicated they would be interested in softball, and another 15 indicated they would be interested in tennis (not currently offered at Miramar College).

Male Applicants' Responses

When male applicants indicated that they would be interested in competing in a sport, they most commonly expressed interest in soccer (n=42), football (n=41), and baseball (n=38), none of which are offered at Miramar College. Male applicants also indicated they would be interested in basketball (n=37), which is offered at Miramar College.
