

Honors Report: 2018-19 Data from 2017-18 and 2018-19

Context

The Honors Program is available to students at San Diego City, Mesa, and Miramar Colleges. In the Honors Program, students explore course topics in greater depth and breadth than in regular courses. Students can participate in the Honors Program through either **Honors Contracts** or **Honors Courses**.

- Honors Contract: A student enters into a mutual agreement with the professor of a regular course; the student completes the regular coursework in addition to additional objectives, readings, and assignments.
- Honors Course: A course in which all enrolled students receive Honors credit. Honors
 courses vary by discipline, but all increase the range and depth of the learning
 experience by stimulating strong critical thinking skills, generating lively discussion,
 facilitating student collaboration, and teaching advanced research and writing skills.

Students may enroll in Honors Contracts, Honors Courses, or both types of courses; similarly, faculty may teach one or both types of courses.

Focus of Analysis

This report includes Honors Program headcount, enrollment, faculty, and section counts for the last two academic years.

Summary

In 2018-19, there were 2,285 students enrolled in the Honors Program. Across the colleges, the majority of these students were enrolled in an Honors Contracts (65%), with 29% enrolled in Honors Courses, and 6% enrolled in both types of courses. The composition of Honors students varied among the colleges: City College and Miramar College Honors students were primarily in Honors Contracts, while almost half of Honors students at Mesa College were in Honors Courses. 


Figure 1. Composition of 2018-19 Honors Students, by College

Program Growth

There was a 12% increase in the number of Honors students from 2017-18 to 2018-19. The proportion of students in Honors Contracts, Honors Courses, and both types of Honors courses has remained relatively stable over the last five years.




Figure 2. Headcount of Honors Students, by Student Type

2018-19 Honors Contracts

In 2018-19, 1,617 students enrolled in 2,306 Honors Contracts. The most common subjects were English, Fine Art, Sociology, Math, and Communications. See page 10 for Honors Contracts enrollments by subject and college.




Figure 3. 2018-19 Top 5 Honors Contracts Enrollments by Subject

2018-19 Honors Courses

In 2018-19, 801 students enrolled in 45 sections of Honors Courses. The most common subjects were English (13 sections), Sociology (4 sections), Fashion, Psychology, Math, and History (3 sections each). See pages 11-12 for Honors Course sections by college and subject.

Demographics

In 2018-19, Honors students across the three colleges were 60% female and 40% male. Latinx students were over-represented (44% of Honors students, compared to 38% of the all colleges population), and White students were under-represented (27% of Honors students, compared to 31% of the all colleges population). The over-representation of Latinx students was particularly pronounced at City College/ECC, where Latinx students comprised 65% of the Honors program compared to 48% of the college population. Faculty

457 faculty taught Honors Contracts, Honors Courses, or both in 2018-19. The majority of these faculty taught Honors Contracts only (421, or 92%). 6 faculty taught only Honors Courses, and 30 taught both types of courses.

Outcomes

2018-19 Honors outcomes have remained largely positive, with 85% of enrollments resulting in a C or better, compared to 73% of non-Honors enrollments. The average Honors GPA was 3.38, compared to 2.83 for non-Honors enrollments. Success rates were higher in Honors Contract enrollments (90%) than in Honors Courses (74%). This pattern was consistent across the colleges. See pages 14-15 for Honors program outcomes.




Figure 4. Honors Retention and Success Rates

Outcomes by Ethnicity

Asian students were the most successful group, followed by African American students. Latinx and Filipino students were the least successful, although it should be noted that all groups of Honors students were more successful than their non-Honors peers.




Figure 5. Honors Success Rates, by Ethnicity
