

Honors Report: 2019-20 Data from 2018-19 and 2019-20 April 19, 2021

Context

The Honors Program is available to students at San Diego City, Mesa, and Miramar Colleges. In the Honors Program, students explore course topics in greater depth and breadth than in regular courses. Students can participate in the Honors Program through either **Honors Contracts** or **Honors Courses**.

- **Honors Contract:** A student enters into a mutual agreement with the professor of a regular course; the student completes the regular coursework in addition to additional objectives, readings, and assignments.
- **Honors Course:** A course in which all enrolled students receive Honors credit. Honors courses vary by discipline, but all increase the range and depth of the learning experience by stimulating strong critical thinking skills, generating lively discussion, facilitating student collaboration, and teaching advanced research and writing skills.

Students may enroll in Honors Contracts, Honors Courses, or both types of courses; similarly, faculty may teach one or both types of courses.

Focus of Analysis

This report includes Honors Program headcount, enrollment, faculty, and section counts, in addition to outcomes (Success, Completion, and GPA) for 2019-20, with some comparisons made to 2018-19. Information is provided by term in some places.

Summary

In 2019-20, there were 2,158 students enrolled in the Honors Program. Across the colleges, the majority of these students were enrolled in an Honors Contracts (60%), with 35% enrolled in Honors Courses, and 5% enrolled in both types of courses. The composition of Honors students varied among the colleges: City College and Miramar College Honors students were primarily in Honors Contracts, while nearly two-thirds of Honors students at Mesa College were in Honors Courses. 



Figure 1. Composition of 2019-20 Honors Students, by College

Slight decrease in Headcount in 2019-20

There was a 6% decrease in the number of Honors students from 2018-19 to 2019-20. Preliminary data from 2020-21 indicates there will likely be a decrease of greater than 40% in that year. Between 2016-17 and 2019-20, the proportion of students in Honors Contracts, Honors Courses, and both types of Honors courses remained relatively stable, with a slightly smaller proportion of students in Honors Contracts only in 2019-20 (60%) compared to prior years (65%-69%).

2019-20 Honors Contracts

In 2019-20, 1,397 students enrolled in 2,044 Honors Contracts. The most common subjects were English, Fine Art, Math, Personal Growth, and Communications. *See page 10 for Honors Contracts enrollments by subject and college.*




Figure 3. 2019-20 Top 5 Honors Contracts Enrollments by Subject

2019-20 Honors Courses

In 2019-20, 872 students enrolled in 43 sections of Honors Courses. The most common subjects were English (11 sections), Fashion (4), Sociology, Psychology, and Math (3 sections each). See pages 11-12 for Honors Course sections by college and subject.

Demographics

In 2019-20 Honors students across the three colleges were 61% female and 39% male. Latinx students were over-represented (44% of Honors students, compared to 39% of non-Honors students), and White students were under-represented (24% of Honors students, compared to 29% of non-Honors students). The over-representation of Latinx students was particularly pronounced at City College/ECC, where Latinx students comprised 62% of the Honors program compared to 49% of the college population. Faculty

370 faculty taught Honors Contracts, Honors Courses, or both in 2019-20. The majority of these faculty taught Honors Contracts only (338, or 91%). 14 faculty taught only Honors Courses, and 18 taught both types of courses.

Outcomes

2019-20 Honors outcomes have remained largely positive, with 83% of enrollments resulting in a C or better, compared to 72% of non-Honors enrollments. The average Honors GPA was 3.07, compared to 2.44 for non-Honors enrollments. Success rates were higher in Honors Contract enrollments (90%) than in Honors Courses (69%). This pattern was consistent across the colleges. *See pages 14-15 for Honors program outcomes.*




Figure 4. 2019-20 Honors Completion and Success Rates

Outcomes by Ethnicity

Asian students were the most successful group (91%), followed by White students (86%). Latinx and Multi-ethnicity students were the least successful, although it should be noted that all groups of Honors students were more successful than their non-Honors peers.




Figure 5. 2019-20 Honors Success Rates, by Ethnicity
