Context

- A. The **Credit Colleges**' Spring classes started on January 30, 2023 and ended on May 27, 2023. There were **3,996 sections** scheduled (**City**: 1,129: **Mesa:** 1,836, **Miramar**: 1,031*).
- B. The **College of Continuing Education** Spring classes started on January 30, 2023 and ended on June 10, 2023. There were **908 sections** scheduled.

Summary

Districtwide, there are 49,251 unique students registered for the Spring term.

Credit Colleges

- FTES: The Credit Colleges reached 11,136
 FTES (City: 2,862; Mesa: 5,173; Miramar: 3,102*).
- FTEF: The Credit Colleges have allocated 824 FTEF (City: 245; Mesa: 367; Miramar: 212*).
- Productivity: The average Productivity for the Credit Colleges is 13.2 (City: 11.7, Mesa: 14.1, Miramar: 13.4).
- 4. The Progress to FTES Target (PTT) is 81% of the overall FTES target for the term

for the credit colleges (**City**: 71%, **Mesa**: 90%, **Miramar**: 80%).

- Headcount: There are 34,112 unduplicated students enrolled across the Credit Colleges (City: 11,970, Mesa: 18,624; Miramar: 12,706*).
- Enrollment: There are 89,744 enrollments across the Credit Colleges (City: 23,540 Mesa: 42,232; Miramar: 23,972*).
