<p>*~ 94A Cosmetology Teacher Training Program I 56 - 63 hours lecture, 48 - 54 hours lab, 4.5 units Grade Only</p> <p>REQUISITES: <i>Advisory:</i> English 101 with a grade of "C" or better, or equivalent or Assessment Skill Levels R6 and W6. <i>Limitation on Enrollment:</i> Student must have a valid California Cosmetology License. This course is not open to students with previous credit for Cosmetology 152A or Cosmetology 91A. This course is offered for the experienced/licensed cosmetologist to become a qualified cosmetology instructor. Training for the course consists of practical and theoretical principles of effective teaching methods, which include lesson planning, oral presentations, evaluations, test construction, and procedures to ensure environmental health and safety. This course is not open to students with previous credit for Cosmetology 152B or Cosmetology 91B. This course is offered for the experienced/licensed cosmetologist to become a qualified cosmetology instructor. Phase II of the Cosmetology Teacher Training program provides the trainee with an opportunity to acquire additional skills, expand career options, workplace skill competencies, and subject mastery skills necessary for teaching the practical aspects of cosmetology science.
