Productivity Report 2008As of End of Term

Purpose

This report has been prepared in order to provide three productivity indicators for the three colleges for the last four spring terms including Spring 08 (all terms excluded intersession).

FTES/FTEF Ratio

FTES & FTEF data are from end of term. As a point of reference, for a Census Week class, an FTES/FTEF ratio of 15 would equate to a class size of 30 students.

• All three colleges showed an improvement in the FTES/FTEF ratio in Spring 2008 compared to Spring 2007.

Fill Rate

The capacity and enrollment data, for all accounting methods, were used to analyze fill rates. Data as of End of Term were used for all four terms. Enrollment as of Census was divided by the course capacity to calculate fill rates. As a point of reference, if there are 25 students in a class with a cap of 40, the fill rate would be 0.63.

• The overall fill rates for Spring 2008 were greater than fill rates for the previous three spring terms for all three colleges.

Yields

Data were used from End of Term to calculate the yields. Yields are calculated by taking the total amount of FTES and dividing the total number of related sections. For example, if the total FTES was 24.83 and there were 5 related sections, the resulting yield would be 4.96.

- All three colleges had an increase in total average yields for Census Week and Census Day sections from 2007 to 2008.
- Mesa and Miramar Colleges had an increase in the total average yield for Spring 2008 that exceeded all the proceeding terms.
