Productivity Report Fall 2008 As of Census

Purpose

This report has been prepared in order to provide three productivity indicators for the three colleges for the last four fall terms including Fall 08.

FTES/FTEF Ratio

FTES data are for census week classes only. As a point of reference, for a Census Week class, an FTES/FTEF ratio of 15 would equate to a class size of 30 students.

• All three colleges showed an improvement in the FTES/FTEF ratio in Fall 2008 compared to the three previous terms.

Fill Rate

The capacity and enrollment data, for all accounting methods, were used to analyze fill rates. Data were as of census were used for all four terms. Enrollment as of census was divided by the course capacity to calculate fill rates. As a point of reference, if there are 25 students in a class with a cap of 40, the fill rate would be 0.63.

• The overall fill rates for Fall 2008 were greater than or equal to fill rates for the previous three fall terms for all three colleges.

Yields

Data were used from census to calculate the yields. Yields are calculated by taking the total amount of FTES and dividing the total number of related sections. For example, if the total FTES were 24.83 and there were 5 related sections, the resulting yield would be 4.96.

• All three colleges had an increase in total average yields in 2008 compared to the previous terms.
