College Productivity Report – Spring 2014 As of Final Census

Purpose

This report has been prepared in order to provide four productivity indicators for City/ECC, Mesa, and Miramar Colleges for the last four spring terms including Spring 2014.

FTES/FTEF Ratio

FTES and FTEF data are from end of term. As a point of reference, for a Census Week class, an FTES/FTEF ratio of 15 would equate to a class size of approximately 30 students.

The FTES/FTEF ratio for Miramar College increased in Spring 2014 compared to the previous term. For Spring 2014, the average class size for each college was as follows: City/ECC 30.6, Mesa 31.8, Miramar 32.9, and District 31.6. The District benchmark (based on the average FTES/FTEF of the reported four fall terms) is 16.6.

Note 1. Non-residents, tutoring, apprenticeship, in-service, non-state supported, and cancelled classes were excluded.

Yields

Data were used from end of term to calculate the yields. Yields are calculated by taking the total amount of FTES and dividing by the total number of related sections. For example, if the total FTES were 24.83 and there were 5 related sections, the resulting yield would be 4.97.

The three colleges showed improvement in a few accounting methods in 2014 compared to the previous term (see Table 2). The City College/ECC yields increased in Independent Study Census Day in Spring 2014 compared to 2013. Miramar College showed improvement in Positive Attendance-Credit Inservice and Work Experience Census Day in Spring 2014 compared to Spring 2013.

Load

Data were used from end of term to calculate the loads. Load is the ratio of Weekly Student Contact Hours (WSCH) to Full-time Equivalent Faculty (WSCH/FTEF) and is a measure of productivity. The statewide load benchmark for a 17.5 semester is 525. The load benchmark for SDCCD's 16.5 week semester is 557.

In Spring 2014, the load value for each college was lower than the four term spring average.

Fill Rate

The capacity and enrollment data, for all accounting methods, were used to analyze fill rates. Data were as of end of term and were used for all four terms. Enrollment as of end of term was divided by the course capacity to calculate fill rates. As a point of reference, if there are 25 students in a class with a cap of 40, the fill rate would be 63%.

The overall fill rates for Spring 2014 decreased by 4% compared to the previous spring term.
