

College Productivity Report Spring 2017

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Purpose

This report has been prepared in order to provide four productivity indicators for City/ECC, Mesa, and Miramar Colleges for the last four spring terms including Spring 2017.

FTES/FTEF Ratio

FTES and FTEF data are from end of term. As a point of reference, for a Census Week class, an FTES/FTEF ratio of 15 would equate to a class size of approximately 30 students.

The FTES/FTEF ratio for all three colleges decreased in Spring 2017 compared to the previous spring term. The FTES/FTEF ratio for Spring 2017 was lower than the four term average (City College/ECC 14.7, Mesa College 14.8, and Miramar 15.3). The All Colleges benchmark (based on the average FTES/FTEF of the reported four spring terms) is 14.9. For Spring 2017, the average class size for each college was as follows: City/ECC 27.9, Mesa 27.9, Miramar 28.7, and All Colleges 28.1.

Yields

Data were used from end of term to calculate the yields. Yields are calculated by taking the total amount of FTES and dividing by the total number of related sections. For example, if the total FTES were 24.83 and there were 5 related sections, the resulting yield would be 4.97.

The three colleges showed improvement in several accounting methods in 2017 compared to the previous spring term (see Table 2.2). The City College/ECC yields increased in Online Census Week and Online Census Day in Spring 2017 compared to 2016. In Spring 2017, Mesa College yields increased in Positive Attendance Credit compared to Spring 2016. Compared to the Spring 2016 the yields for all accounting methods for Miramar College decreased slightly in Spring 2017.

Load

Data were used from end of term to calculate the loads. Load is the ratio of Weekly Student Contact Hours (WSCH) to Full-time Equivalent Faculty (WSCH/FTEF) and is a measure of productivity. The statewide load benchmark for a 17.5 week semester is 525. The load benchmark for SDCCD's 16.5 week semester is 557.

In Spring 2017, the Load for each college was less than the four term spring average.

Fill Rate

The capacity and enrollment data, for all accounting methods, were used to analyze fill rates. Data were as of end of term and were used for all four terms. Enrollment as of end of term was divided by the course capacity to calculate fill rates. As a point of reference, if there are 25 students in a class with a cap of 40, the fill rate would be 63%.

The overall fill rates for Spring 2017 decreased by 2% compared to the previous spring term.
