

College Productivity Report Fall 2017

Prepared by: SDCCD Office of Institutional Research and Planning February 2018

Purpose

This report has been prepared in order to provide four productivity indicators for City/ECC, Mesa, and Miramar Colleges for the last four fall terms including Fall 2017.

FTES/FTEF Ratio

FTES and FTEF data are from end of term. As a point of reference, for a Census Week class, an FTES/FTEF ratio of 15 would equate to a class size of approximately 30 students.

The FTES/FTEF ratio for all three colleges decreased in Fall 2017 compared to the previous fall term. The FTES/FTEF ratio for Fall 2017 was lower than the four term average (City College/ECC 14.9, Mesa College 14.9, and Miramar 15.6). The All Colleges benchmark (based on the average FTES/FTEF of the reported four fall terms) is 15.1. For Fall 2017, the average class size for each college was as follows: City/ECC 28.9, Mesa 28.4, Miramar 30.3, and All Colleges 29.0.

Yields

Data were used from end of term to calculate the yields. Yields are calculated by taking the total amount of FTES and dividing by the total number of related sections. For example, if the total FTES were 24.83 and there were 5 related sections, the resulting yield would be 4.97.

The three colleges showed improvement in several accounting methods in Fall 2017 compared to the previous fall term (see Table 2.2). The City College/ECC yields increased for Census Week and Work Experience, Census Week in Fall 2017 compared to Fall 2016. Mesa College yields increased in Online Census Day in Fall 2017 compared to Fall 2016. Miramar College showed improvement in Census Week, In-service and Work Experience Census Day in Fall 2017 compared to Fall 2017 compared to Fall 2017.

Load

Data were used from end of term to calculate the loads. Load is the ratio of Weekly Student Contact Hours (WSCH) to Full-time Equivalent Faculty (WSCH/FTEF) and is a measure of productivity. The statewide load benchmark for a 17.5 week semester is 525. The load benchmark for SDCCD's 16.5 week semester is 557.

In Fall 2017, the Load for each college was less than the four term fall average.

Fill Rate

The capacity and enrollment data, for all accounting methods, were used to analyze fill rates. Data were as of end of term and were used for all four terms. Enrollment as of end of term was divided by the course capacity to calculate fill rates. As a point of reference, if there are 25 students in a class with a cap of 40, the fill rate would be 63%.

The overall fill rates for Fall 2017 decreased by 2% compared to the previous fall term.
