Fall 2001 ClassTalk Survey Results

March, 2002 Office of Institutional Research

The purpose of this survey is to assess students' opinions regarding more flexible class schedule and short-term classes. Data were collected during Fall 2001 registration. More than 3,000 students responded to the survey Districtwide. The results are summarized bellow:

- Over 64% of the students would like to take classes on weekdays at City, Mesa, and Miramar. Nearly forty-nine percent (48.7%) of the ECC students preferred weekday classes and 33% selected weekdays and weekends.
- About 40% of the students preferred morning classes (before noon) at City, Mesa, and Miramar. Over thirty-seven
 percent (37.5%) of the ECC students would like to attend early evening (5:00pm-7:00pm) classes. Districtwide,
 about 9% of the respondents indicated that they would take late evening (after 7:00pm) classes.
- More students preferred classes that meet for 1.5 hours, 2 times each week than other class schedules (City=38.7%, Mesa=47%, Miramar=40.5%). Most ECC students (51.2%) preferred classes that meet for 3 hours, once a week.
- Over 67% of the students thought the colleges should offer more online classes.
- About 50% of the students suggested that the college should offer more general education transfer classes using multiple formats, i.e., weekends and evenings, short-term, and online classes.
- Districtwide, about 55% of the students would be interested in a one-class-per-month format.
- About 48% of the students, Districtwide, would be interested in taking both 6-week and 8-week short-term classes.
- Districtwide, 60% of the students were interested in taking a class during winter break (January).
