Highlight of the Findings

HIGHLIGHT OF THE FINDINGS

District

1. Overall, the number of awards conferred for the District increased by 11%, from 4,656 in 2010/11 to 5,162 in 2011/12.

All Colleges

- 1. Overall, the number of awards conferred (degrees and certificates) is up 8% from last year, with 3,561 awards conferred in 2011/12, up from 3,284 in 2010/11. In fact, the number of awards conferred in 2011/12 is the highest it has been in over five years.
- 2. Among awards conferred from 2007/08 to 2011/12, on average, AA/AS degrees were conferred three times more (66%) than all other certificates combined (34%). However, when considering only certificates, certificates requiring 29 or fewer units and certificates requiring 30 to 59 units were conferred equally (49% each), followed by certificates requiring 60 or more units with the fewest conferred (1%).
- 3. In 2011/12, AA/AS degrees accounted for approximately 60% of the awards conferred at City College, 76% of the awards conferred at Mesa College, and 60% of the awards conferred at Miramar College.

4. Between 2007/08 and 2011/12, the top 5 awards conferred (degrees and certificates) were as follows (excluding transfer studies and liberal arts): Business Administration (n = 988), Fire Technology (n = 530), Biology-Allied Health (n = 500), Social/Behavioral Sciences (n = 425), and Behavioral Sciences-Alcohol & Other Drug Studies (n = 355).

- 5. The top 5 AA/AS degrees conferred between 2007/08 and 2011/12 were as follows (excluding transfer studies and liberal arts): Biology-Allied Health (n = 500), Business Administration (n = 482), Social/Behavioral Sciences (n = 425), Child Development (n = 352), and Psychology (n = 314).
- 6. Between 2007/08 and 2011/12, the Radiologic Technology certificate was the top certificate conferred requiring 60 or more units (n = 55).
- 7. For certificates requiring 30 to 59 units, the top certificates conferred between 2007/08 and 2011/12 were as follows: Business Administration (n = 501), Behavioral Sciences-Alcohol & Other Drug Studies (n = 249), Cosmetology (n = 140), Interior Design (n = 116), and Radiologic Technology (n = 97).
- 8. The top 5 certificates conferred between 2007/08 and 2011/12 requiring 29 or fewer units were as follows: Child Development Teacher (n = 314), Child Development Associate Teacher (n = 280), Fire Technology (n = 222), Building Trades-Electrical (n = 176), and Electricity (n = 135).

Continuing Education

- 1. Overall, the number of awards conferred (certificates, GEDs, and high school diplomas) at Continuing Education increased by 17% from last year, with 1,601 awards conferred in 2011/12, up from 1,372 in 2010/11.
- 2. Between 2007/08 and 2011/12, Certificates of Completion represented the majority of awards conferred at Continuing Education (88%), followed by high school diplomas (6%) and GED certificates (6%).

- 3. The number of Certificates of Completion conferred increased by 27% since last year, with 1,408 conferred in 2011/12, up from 1,113 in 2010/11.
- 4. The number of GED certificates conferred decreased by 32% since last year, with 101 conferred in 2011/12, down from 148 in 2010/11.
- 5. The number of high school diplomas decreased by 17% since last year, with 92 conferred in 2011/12, down from 111 in 2010/11.
- 6. The top 5 programs that awarded Certificates of Completion between 2007/08 and 2011/12 were as follows: Nursing Assistant Training (n = 458), Culinary Arts I (n = 241), Culinary Arts V (n = 232), Culinary Arts III (n = 210), and Culinary Arts IV (n = 199).






City College Percentage Distribution of Awards by Year




Mesa College Percentage Distribution of Awards by Year
