Make a Call

- Uff the handset OR
- 3 Press (1)
- 5 Dial the number OR
- 7 Press a Speed Call key OR
- 4 Press 123 OR
- 5 Dial the prefix for external calls (e.g. 0) and the number.

Answer a Call

- Lift the handset OR
- 3 Press (), and begin speaking.

End a Call

- 4 Press X OR
- Page 2 Replace the handset.

Place a Call on Hold

- 4 Press . The line key flashes.
- Property Property

Retrieve a Call from Hold

- Lift the handset OR
- 3 Press (1).
- Press the flashing line key.

Retrieve a Message

4 Press . It flashes when a message is waiting. Follow the voice mail prompts to retrieve your message.

Transfer a Call

4 Press A M.

Dial the number. Wait for an

Hang up OR announce the transfer and then hang up.

Conference a Call

- 4 Press $\sim \mathfrak{M}$.
- 5 Dial the number. Wait for an answer.
- 4 Press A M.

Program a Speed Call

4 Press Settings OR

Press Programmable Kevs.

Press the key you wish to program.

Press Speed Call.

Press Edit Label and enter the label for the Speed Call.

Press Save.

Press Edit Number and enter the phone number for the Speed Call.

Press Save, and then press Save again.

Press Close and then press Close again.

Adjust Volume Levels

Adjust ringer volume while the phone is ringing. Adjust handset or speaker volume while using the handset or speaker.

- 3 Press repeatedly to raise the volume
- OR repeatedly to lower the volume.
